Proposed by Sharon and Pietro. Agreed unanimously. MH/RD Mike and Ralph to set up IT access & website information. **Financial Situation & Membership Numbers** 3 See Matt's report. General income and gross profit are still, as predicted, in decline. Net profit is stable because of control of costs. We need to maintain our current reserves, but if they rise we should increase spending to improve member's benefits. Previously agreed spending limits were confirmed: Club Office <£1200 <£5000 Treasurer, >£5000 Chairman+Treasurer. Matt had obtained alternative costs for our accounting & auditing. MM Current providers are very competitive. Matt to keep under review. Ali reported current membership is 5435. 4 Meeting with Dietrich Probst of TVR Motors and Dom of TVR Power Tony summarised his meeting, but felt it had been overtaken somewhat AII/ML by Nicolai Smolensky's Autosport (wind turbines) article! Our priority must always be membership benefits. Dietrich's work for Nicolai is about 20% TVR and 80% other projects. The possible link with the Germans didn't prove viable so was not followed up. TVR Motors wouldn't want to merchandise TVR Motors items using their registered logo ~ this could TC be an opportunity for us. Tony to contact Dietrich to discuss things. We should also approach David Gerald about use of Vixen & M Series TC logos. Dietrich said he was keen to set up an official service and dealership network and the parts agreement with Multipart was likely to be renewed as it seemed to be working well. TVR Power has been renamed as Power Performance in-line with Dom's decision to diversify. 5 Regions Mervyn circulated Mal's summary. Mervyn & Sharon to liaise with Mal to SB/ML/MG discuss actions and report back to next meeting. Mandy volunteered to help with RO reports as long as Mal can just MG/MO check word limits.
